

We believe Holy Communion to be a sign that in Christ we have all things in common, share an identical faith, and are united fully to the Orthodox Church. Holy Communion can be given to Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves through prayer, fasting (no food or drink from a light lunch), the Sacrament of Confession (7 years and older) within the last 2 months, being at peace with others, and attending the Divine Liturgy regularly. Everyone is invited to the final blessing and receive Holy Bread at the end of Liturgy.



This is the Day of Resurrection, be illumined, people; Pascha, the Lord's Pascha! From death unto life, from the earth to Heaven, hath Christ our God led us; singing the song of victory!

From the 1st Ode of the Paschal Canon
