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Welcome to St. George! Thank you for attending today's Divine Services. If you are a firsttime visitor, please register your visit by completing the guest book located in the narthex. We would appreciate getting to meet you after liturgy, so feel free to join us during Coffee Fellowship! Every Sunday we remember the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. The word "Liturgy" means work of the people that means everyone participates through singing, praying, hearing the teaching, and opening our hearts to allow God's grace to enter. Anyone interested in learning more about our faith are encouraged to speak with one of our clergy.

Guidelines for Receiving Holy Communion for Orthodox Christians: Orthodox Christians fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist by receiving Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's command to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly prepared to receive Holy Communion, the faithful should fast (no food or drink from midnight the night before), the Sacrament of Confession (7 years and older) within the last 2 months, being at peace with others, and striving to always love God and their neighbor. Frequent communion and regular confession are recommended for all faithful Orthodox Christians.

For other Christians: We welcome you to this celebration of the Divine Liturgy. Unfortunately we cannot extend to you a general invitation to receive Holy Communion. Orthodox Christian's believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a

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Ing a oneness in faith, life, and worship of our community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, but for which we must all pray. All, however, are welcome to partake of the blessed bread (antidoron) which will be given when coming forward to venerate (kiss) the Holy Cross and receive the final blessing from the priest. Again, welcome!

Saint of the day

On November 24 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we continue to celebrate the Entrance of the Theotokos into the Holy of Holies, and we commemorate our father among the saints Clement, bishop of Rome.

Verses

Cast into the depth of the sea with an anchor, Clement cometh to Christ, the uttermost Anchor. On the twenty-fourth Clement drowned in the depths of Christ.

Clement was born in Rome of royal lineage. His family had become lost at sea, so Clement, at age 24, went east to find them. In Alexandria, he met the Apostle Barnabas and, afterward, joined the Apostle Peter whom Clement's two brothers, Faustinus and Faustinian, were already following. By God's providence, the Apostle Peter came upon Clement's mother as an aged beggar woman, and then found his father as well. Thus, the whole family was reunited, and all returned to Rome as Christians. Clement served as third bishop of Rome, bringing a great number of unbelievers to Christ. He ordered seven scribes to write the lives of the Christian martyrs who were suffering at that time for their Lord. The Emperor Trajan banished him to Cherson, where Clement found about 2,000 exiled Christians who received him with great joy. In one year, 75 churches were built there. The authorities drowned Clement in the sea in the year 101. His miracleworking relics emerged from the sea in the ninth century. On this day, we also commemorate the Hieromartyr Peter, bishop of Alexandria

عاشا عيشة بسيطة مع تكريس صارم . ولعل تواضعهما ارضى الله جدا ، فاختارهما في النهاية من بين الجميع ، ليصيرا الوالدين القديسين لوالدة الاله المباركة ، فصارا تباعا جدّي الفادي القدوس يسوع المسيح ،

كانت شخصية القديسين يواكيم وحنة مثالية ، وتحتذى ، لأن سيرتهما كانت تتجه نحو الامور الروحية لا المادية ، فقد اختارا ان يوزعا ثلث مدخولهما على الهيكل ، والثلث الاخر ، على المساكين والفقراء ، تاركين الباقي لمعيشتهما ، وقد تدبرا ذلك بفرح ، كما ان اقتصادهما في الانفاق سبق ان انبأ عن ولادة مخلصناً الذي سيبدأ حياته في احوال وضيعة جدا محاطا بحيوانات الحقل والرعاة في المزود .

كان يواكيم من سبط يهوذا ، وقد انحدر من الملك داوود ، اما زوجته الورعة حنة فقد ولدت لكاهن معروف جدًا من قبيلة لاوي يدعى ناثان ، وكان له ثلاث بنات (مريم ، زويا ،وحنة) تزوجت مريم في بيت لحم فصارت ام صالومي ، بينما زويا التي تزوجت في بيت لحم ايضا ، فكانت ام اليصابات والدة القديس يوحنا السابق ،

تزوج يواكيم وحنة في الناصرة ، وعاشا معاً سيرة ورعة وهادئة برضا وسلام ، الا ان صفو سعادتهما عكّرته خيبة ملتهبة : بعد خمسين سنة مرت على زواجهما ، لم يكن لهما ولد ، وكان عهدهما الزوجي مؤلما ، فمن يكون بدون اولاد ، في ذلك الزمان ، يعدّ منتقصا اخلاقيا .

ثم ان الكربة التي احس بها الزوجان العاقران ، كانت لا تطاق ، وحدث عندما كان الكاهن في الهيكل ، كان هناك اكليريكي لا قلب له يدعى رؤبين ، هذا وبّخ يواكيم قائلا له انه غير جدير بتقديم الذبائح ، منذ ذلك الحين ، لم يعد يسمح له بالاشـتراك في تقديم ذبائح الهيكل ، وهذا امر قاتل بالنسـبة ليواكيم الكثير التقوى والورع .

وبينما كان يواكيم ينظر بدهشة ، بحسب الرسول يعقوب ، تكلم الملاك وسط نور مبهر شديد الضياء وقال : " انا ملاك الرب ، ارسلت اليك كي اعلن لك ان صلواتك قد استجيبت ، وصدقاتك ارتفعت الى عيني الرب ، لقد رأيت عارك وسمعت خزي عقركما الحال عليكما عن خطأ ، الله لا يقاصص الطبيعة بل الخطيئة فقط ، لذلك فعندما يغلق رحما ، فذلك كي يعود فيفتحه لاحقا على نحو مذهل ، فيعرف الجميع ان ما يولد ، لا يكون ثمرة الشهوة ، بل من الجود الالهي " ألم تحمل سارة الالم الاولى في سلالتك ، عار العقم حتى التسعين من عمرها ، ومن ثم ولدت اسحاق الذي له كان الوعد ببركة جميع الامم ؟ الم تكن راحيل عاقرا ، ومع ذلك فقد وضعت يوسف الذي صار حاكما لكل
