

The Ecclesiastical (Church) New Year - September 1st

- ➤ The first day of the Church New Year is also called the *Indiction*. The term *Indiction* comes from a Latin word meaning, "to impose." It was originally applied to the imposition of taxes in Egypt. The first worldwide *Indiction* was in 312 when the Emperor Constantine (remembered on May 21st) saw a miraculous vision of the Cross in the sky. Before the introduction of the Julian calendar, the Roman Empire began the New Year on September 1st.
- According to Holy Tradition, Christ entered the synagogue on September 1st to announce His mission to mankind (Luke 4:16-22). Quoting Isaiah 61:1-2, our Savior proclaimed, "The spirit of the Lord is upon me; because He has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent me to proclaim release to captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord...".
- > Tradition also says the Old Testament Hebrews entered the Promised Land in September.




